How to Submit Your Production Registration Form and required Deliverables:

- 1. Fill out the Production Registration Form (PRF), print two copies of the completed report, keep a copy for your files. (Note: If you are using the free Adobe Acrobat Reader, your form data *will not save or send*, you *must* print hard copies. If you are using Adobe Acrobat Professional, your form data will save. Save it to desktop, print copies, send electronic version via secure email)
- 2. Request a *secure* email from the Hawaii Film Office to submit the HPR. Once you receive a *secure* email, reply on that email chain with PRF and below deliverables attached.
- **3.** Submit all the following Deliverables (Deliverables can be submitted on a thumb drive (or in person) with the printed Hard Copy of the signed PRF, if so desired):
 - 1) PRF (Production Registration Form) filled out completely, dated and signed;
 - 2) Business Registration (proof of) with every state agency requiring registration to do business in the State of Hawaii;
 - 3) Synopsis (detailed) synopsis of production if space on form provided does not suffice and/or script if it exists where applicable;
 - 4) Estimated Budget (preliminary) with top sheet summary and category breakdown, by island if filming on more than one island;

5. The Hawaii Film Office will review your PRF and follow up with any further questions. If, based on the information you provided, the production is eligible for the credit, they will issue a Pre-Qualification letter to the filing entity, acknowledging the registration for the Production Tax Credit. Please note: The Pre-Qualification letter is for informational purposes and does not guarantee your qualification for the Motion Picture, Digital Media and Film Production Income Tax Credit. Qualification for the tax credit is subject to your meeting all applicable conditions and requirements. The Department of Taxation (DOTAX) is the ultimate arbiter of tax credit disbursements, and your credit eligibility is ultimately subject to the Department's review and, in some cases, audit.
